### **Health and Safety Advisor September 2005 – to date:**

My initial duties upon joining Southampton Cargo Handling, based within the docks estate of Southampton, were to act as the assistant health and safety advisor. This duty was to provide safety advice on the turnaround movement of cargo and the cruise ship operation within the port, advice to the workforce, maintain management systems, develop policies and consult with national governing bodies. Having proven my abilities I gain the addition roles and was promoted to Manger of the above areas. In addition to these tasks my past experience within the field of engineering was used to manage the vehicle maintenance and facilities maintenance department. Implementing and developing the departments to bring them in line of mandatory inspection requirements, planned maintenance and making efficiency recommendations to the board of governors.

My principle Health and Safety duties included developing the companies respective policies, developing and implementing a management system based on HS(G) 65. I constantly reported and informed the board of changing legislation, liasing and reincarnating the Union based safety committee, informing the employees of changing practices. Given the nature of the industry I had a very close working relationship with the HSE and other safety professionals within my sphere of influence. Additional responsibilities included conducting site inspections, accident investigation and fire risk assessments for the docks estate.
